



# Livingston State Forest

Livingston, Germantown, Catskill - WMU 3J, 4Y

The 319-acre Livingston State Forest features scenic views of the Hudson River and opportunities for a variety of uses. It is about a mile south of Olana State Historic site.

There are no designated hiking trails on the property. There is an old railroad bed that crosses the property. A high speed railroad blocks drive access. Camping is allowed 150 ft from the Foxes Creek and roads in the area.
