

Griggs Gulf State Forest encompasses 2,346 acres across Cortland and Tioga counties. This primitive landscape features northern hardwoods and hemlocks, providing a peaceful escape for hiking, snowmobiling, and hunting. Visitors can explore the "Hidden Falls" waterfall or follow truck trails along a creek home to blue herons.
