DURING THE AMERICAN REVOLUTION. HE WAS
SA-GO-YE-WA-SHA (HE WHO KEEPS THEM AWAKE)
HE BECAME KNOWN AS RED JACKET AFTER HE
WAS GIVEN A SCARLET JACKET BY THE BRITISH
AT THE END OF THE REVOLUTIONARY WAR.
IN 1782, GEORGE WASHINGTON PRESENTED HIM
WITH A LARGE SILVER MEDAL WHICH HE
IS DEPICTED WEARING HERE.

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
