

Frank E. Jadwin Memorial State Forest is one of New York's largest and most diverse forests, spanning over 20,000 acres in Lewis County. It features hardwood forests, conifer plantations, and extensive wetlands. Visitors enjoy 27 miles of multi-use trails for hiking, primitive camping, hunting, and fishing in trout-filled streams.
