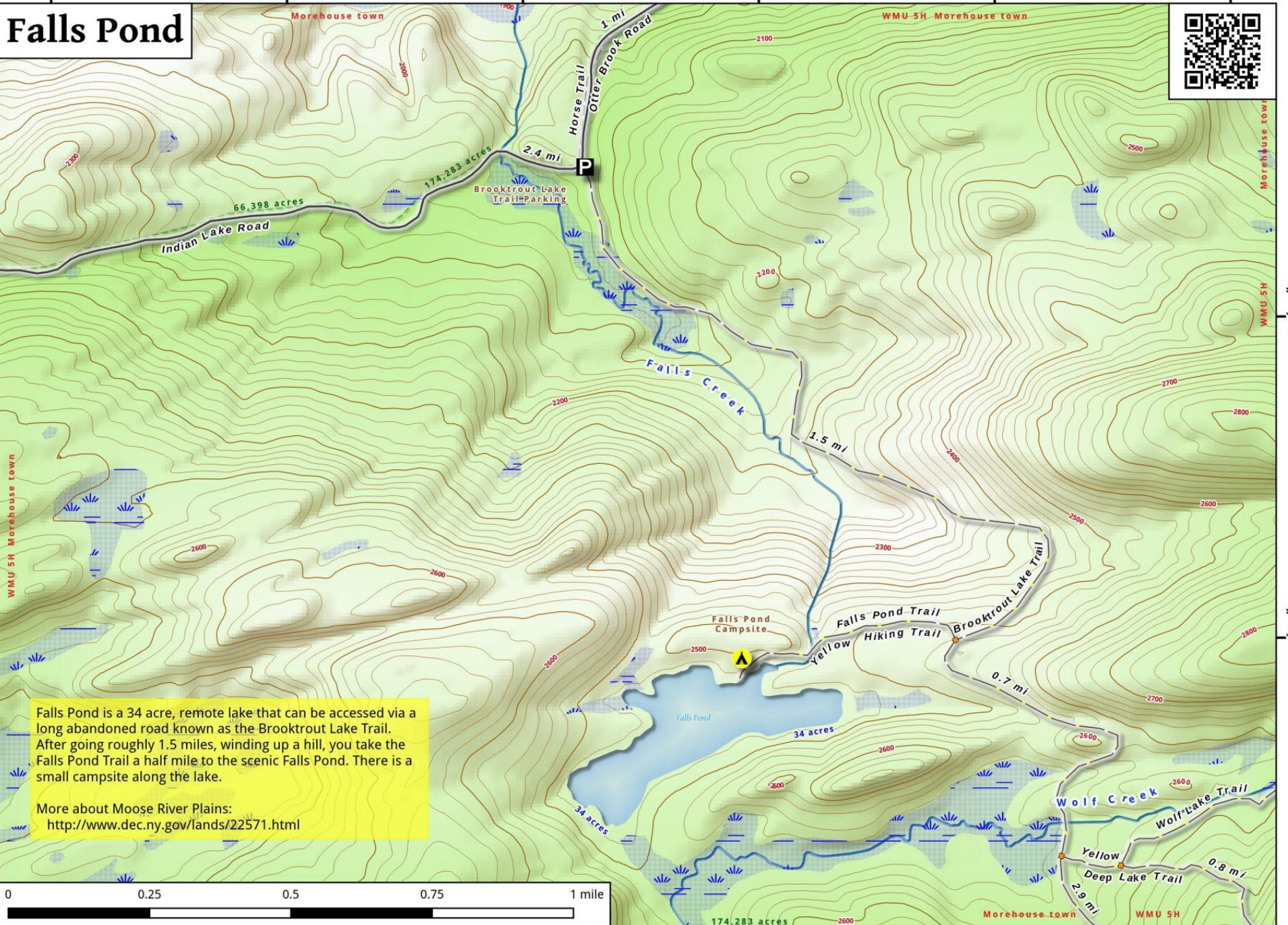

Falls Pond



Falls Pond is a 34 acre, remote lake that can be accessed via a long abandoned road known as the Brooktrout Lake Trail. After going roughly 1.5 miles, winding up a hill, you take the Falls Pond Trail a half mile to the scenic Falls Pond. There is a small campsite along the lake.
