



Peter Scott Swamp is a generalized state identified significant wildlife habitat and is the largest wetland complex associated with the Oneida River. The state has preserved 402 acres of this land in the state nature and historic preserve, off of Peter Scott Road in the Town of Schroeppel in Oswego County.
