

Tracy Creek State Forest (Stueben 16)

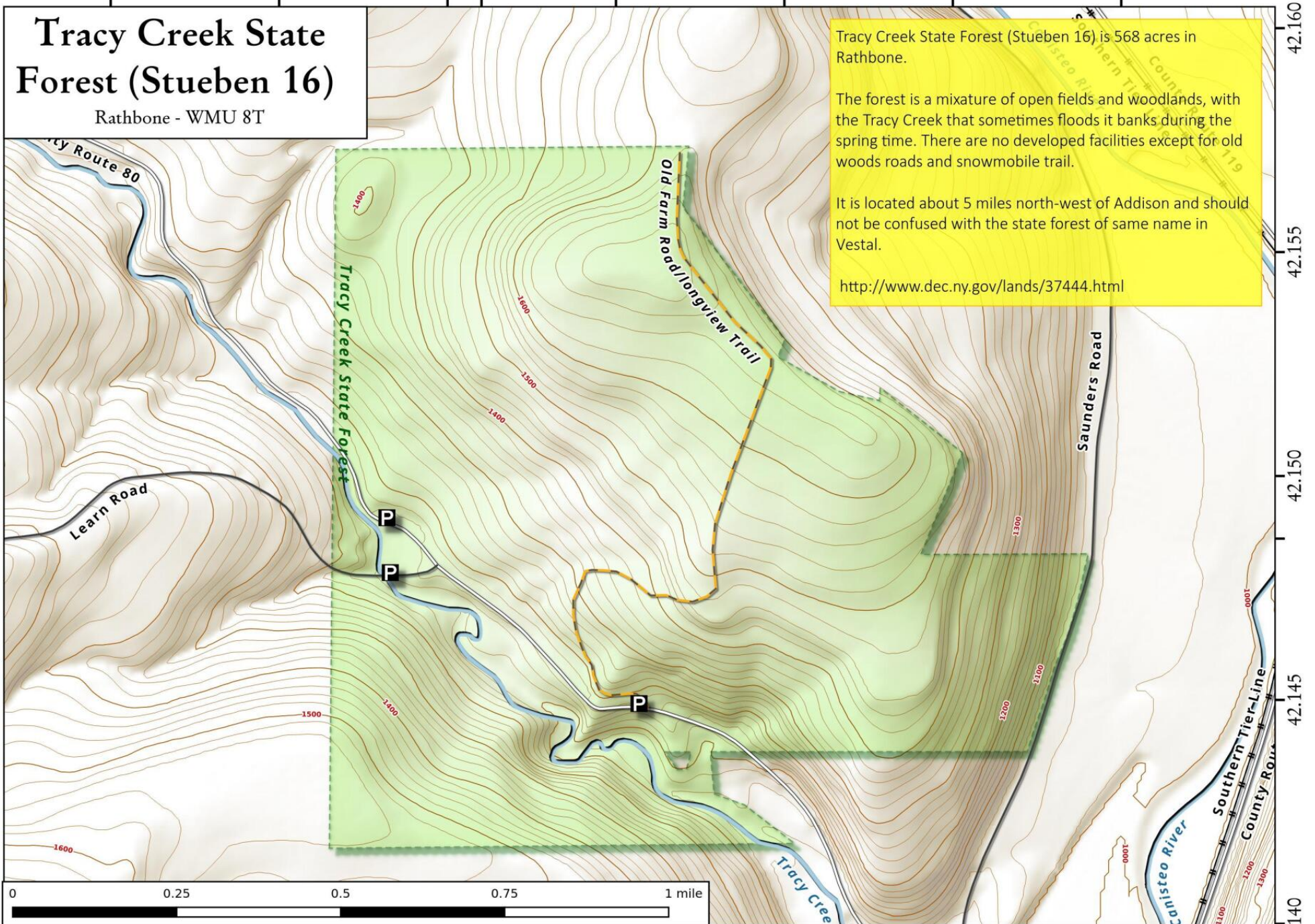

Tracy Creek State Forest (Stueben 16) is 568 acres in Rathbone.

The forest is a mixture of open fields and woodlands, with the Tracy Creek that sometimes floods it banks during the spring time. There are no developed facilities except for old woods roads and snowmobile trail.

It is located about 5 miles north-west of Addison and should not be confused with the state forest of same name in Vestal.
