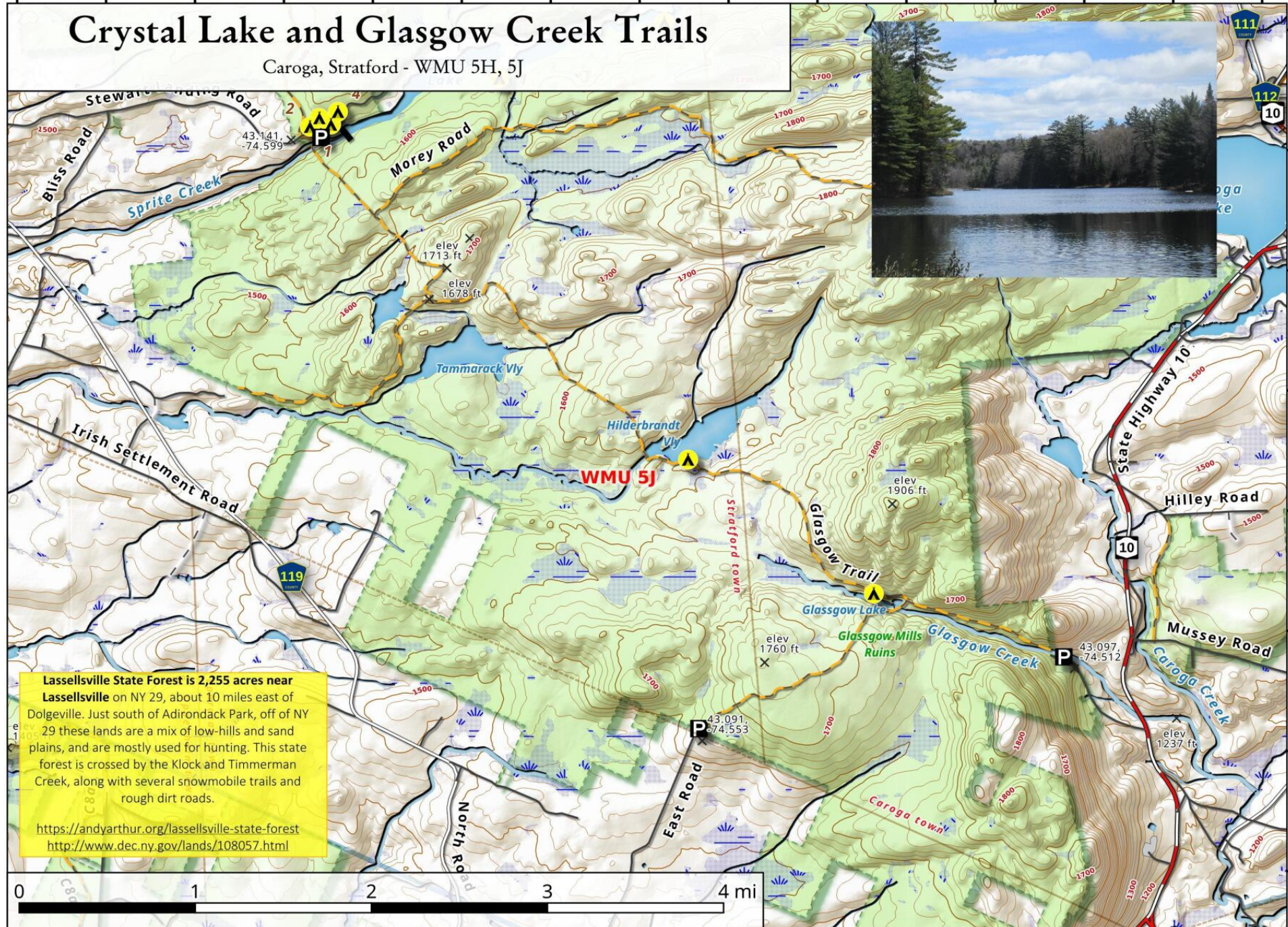

Lassellville State Forest is 2,255 acres near Lassellville on NY 29, about 10 miles east of Dolgeville. Just south of Adirondack Park, off of NY 29 these lands are a mix of low-hills and sand plains, and are mostly used for hunting. This state forest is crossed by the Klock and Timmerman Creek, along with several snowmobile trails and rough dirt roads.
