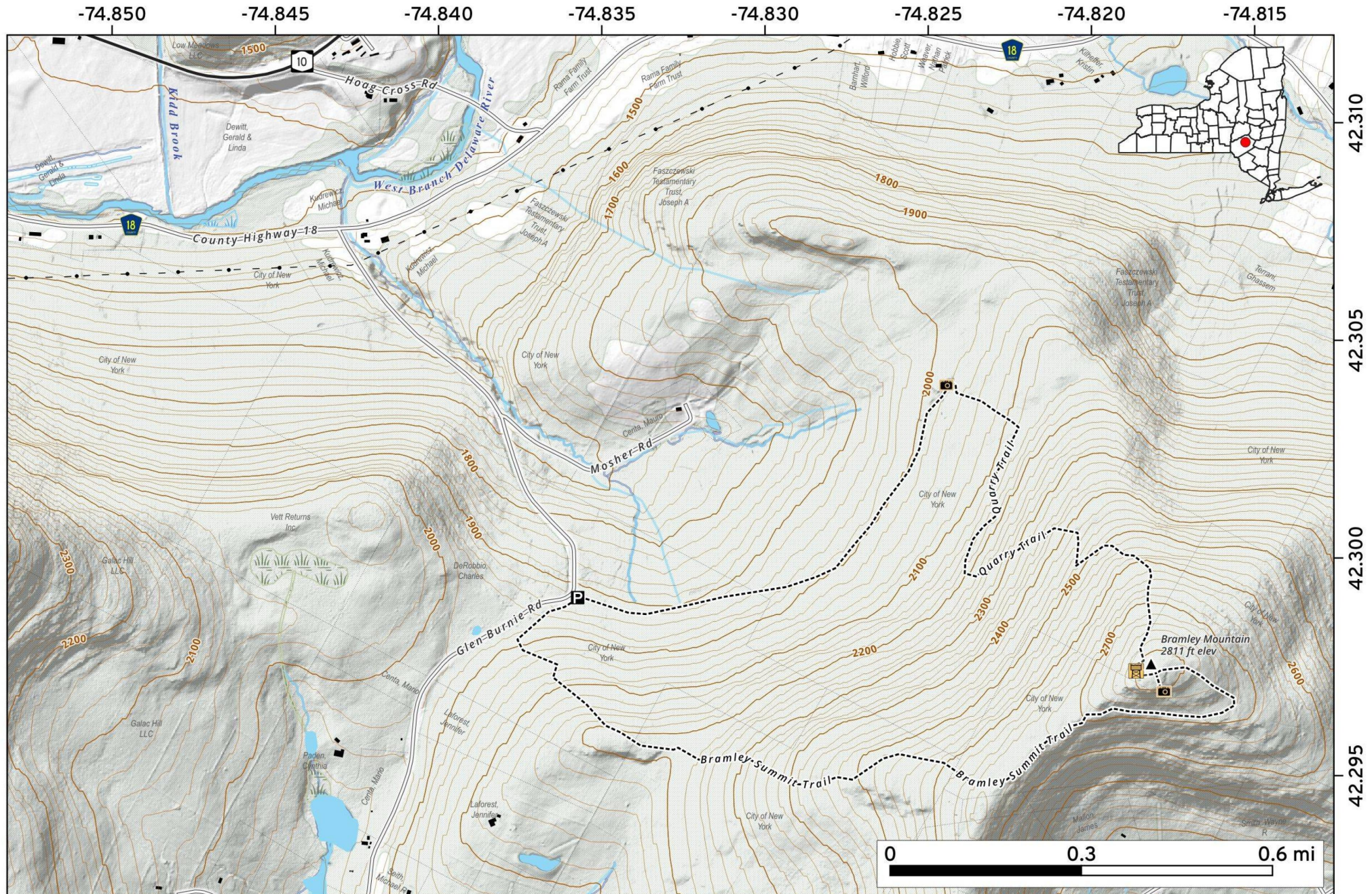


The **Bramley Mountain Fire Tower** hike is a moderate, 4-mile loop trail located near Delhi and Bovina in the Western Catskills. Managed by the Catskill Mountain Club and the NYC Department of Environmental Protection, the trail features a rich mix of geologic and historical markers, including an abandoned bluestone quarry, impressive caves, and a fully restored 1925 historic fire tower at the 2,817-foot summit.
